Booking Your Stay

1. To book a sleeping room, follow the Hotel Reservation link located at www.cleinman.com/dallas2021/ (it will automatically give you event pricing)
2. Insert the information it requests (Name, address, credit card, room request...etc)
3. Click 'Check Out' and you are all set

There are a few ways you can get to Addison, TX.

1. Airplane
 - a. There are two options. You can either fly into Dallas/Fort Worth International Airport (DFW) or Dallas Love Field (DAL). DFW is about 20 miles from the hotel and DAL is about 12.
 - b. Now you arrived at the airport and are probably wondering "how do I get to the hotel?" There are a few options here! You can either:
 - i. Uber/Lyft by downloading one of their apps and inserting the location you would like to go. You then will be chosen by a nearby driver and be on your way.
 - ii. Taxi
 - iii. Rental Car – But keep in mind there is an event parking fee of \$10 per day
 - iv. Super Shuttle: reservation required
 - v. Bus – If you are flying into DAL
2. Car
 - a. If you are driving to the hotel, there is a daily event rate parking fee of \$10. The hotel's website offers great driving directions. Plug in the location you are traveling from, click "get directions" and it populates directions for you. Or, simply enter the address below into your mobile GPS.

3. Train
 - a. You can book a ticket to Eddie Bernice Johnson Union Station. It is about 20 mins from the hotel. Once you have arrived you can either Uber, Lyft or taxi to the hotel.
